The <u>conventional</u> banking system is based on the <u>principle</u> that the more you have, the more you can borrow. However, Grameen Bank, which is a <u>private</u> bank in Bangladesh, gives <u>priority</u> to those who have nothing, <u>particularly</u> the poorest women. The **loans** are small and <u>repayments</u> are made in small amounts <u>spread</u> over a year, with a built-in <u>insurance</u> scheme so that the family doesn't become <u>responsible</u> for the loan if something happens to the <u>borrower</u>. There is no <u>legal</u> contract between the bank and the borrower, and no danger of <u>legal action</u> if the repayments are not made – the relationship is <u>based</u> on <u>trust</u> and good <u>faith</u>. Repayment <u>rates</u>, on the other hand, are very high for two main reasons. Firstly, borrowers know that they cannot borrow again if they don't repay the first loan. And secondly, they must join a group of other borrowers who all share some responsibility for other members' loans and are encouraged to make group decisions. So there is <u>considerable</u> <u>peer pressure</u> and <u>support</u> from the group to <u>encourage</u> them to pay it all back.


